Dear Friends,

On Friday, March 2, 2012, St. Augustine Health Campus will hold its annual **Top O' the Towers Benefit Night** at LaCentre in Westlake. This major event includes great food, a live band, live and silent auction and more. Over 600 will be in attendance to support a very important cause.

St. Augustine Health Campus, a leader in the community for serving the most vulnerable, was founded in 1969 and is home to over 350 chronically ill, medically complex, and aging individuals from all faiths and all walks of life. St. Augustine is located in the city, where all have access to quality care and services including skilled nursing, long-term care, rehabilitation, hospice and assisted living. 75% of those we serve receive Medicaid and would not have access to quality care elsewhere.

The recent cuts in Medicaid funding have created a shortfall of approx. \$52 per Medicaid resident per day, or \$1.5 million each year. Many of the services and equipment needed by Medicaid residents, such as oxygen, over the counter medications, transportation to and from out of facility tests and doctor appointments, rehabilitation, and wheelchairs are no longer fully covered. However, we remain committed to providing access and quality care to all, especially those who can not afford it ~ the most vulnerable.
