**Top O' the Towers Benefit is Huge Success
Over \$140,000 Raised for St. Augustine Health Campus for Elevator Renovations**

CLEVELAND – This year's 10th Annual Top O' the Towers Benefit Night at Brennan's Party Center on Friday, March 2, 2007, was a booming success, drawing the largest crowd to date and raising \$140,000.

Approx. 500 people attended the benefit, enjoying a night full of food, drinks, entertainment, and prizes. The Porter Sharks provided Irish music. Guests had the opportunity to participate in a raffle and bid on over 120 silent auction prizes.

Attendees joined St. Augustine Health Campus in honoring The Most Reverend Anthony M. Pilla, Bishop Emeritus of Cleveland, for his dedication and commitment to the sick and elderly, during a toast by Patrick Gareau, President/CEO of St. Augustine and Tom Lynch, committee co-chair.

All of the \$100,000 raised from the Top O' the Towers event will go to renovating the worn mechanical and electrical components of elevators which date back to the late 1950's. As a 501 (c)3 long-term care, skilled nursing, rehabilitation and assisted living facility located in the old St. John's Hospital building on Cleveland's Near West Side, the elevators are crucial in getting residents, equipment, food, etc. throughout a six-story building.
