This year marks our 40th anniversary of service to the chronically ill and aging. During the course of these 40 years, what started as a nursing home with 124 residents has grown into a Health Campus that serves 350 individuals from all walks of life, with a variety of illnesses, disabilities and age-related needs.

In 2004, Holy Family Home became a part of our family. Shortly thereafter Holy Family Hospice was born out of a strategic plan designed to bring Holy Family's ministry to those in need of care in their own homes. With the opening of Emerald Village Retirement Community in 2007, our Health Ministries now extend well beyond our Campus.

As the largest employer in the Detroit Shoreway neighborhood, we are recognized as a cornerstone in the area. We are in the middle of an exciting rebirth of the neighborhood, with the establishment of the Arts District including the reopening of the Capitol Theater, and the extensive streetscape project along Detroit Avenue. New restaurants, new and redeveloped housing, and new art galleries make this an exciting place to live and work.

Over the past 40 years, St. Augustine has earned a reputation for exceptional clinical care as evidenced through resident outcomes & surveys. St. Augustine is respected in the community for providing excellent and innovative care.

We look forward to the future with excitement and anticipation. ANNUAL REPORT

Budget Update

The 2010-2011 Ohio budget shifts the financial responsibility for many of the services provided to Medicaid recipients from Medicaid to the Nursing Facility. Although each skilled nursing provider will receive the same \$3.92 per day increase in their Medicaid rate, those who care for the more chronically ill will have a greater challenge.

Services that were once directly billed to Medicaid are now the responsibility of the nursing facility and should be covered by the \$3.91 increase in rate.

- Over the counter medications: \$.03
- Skilled therapies (physical, occupational, speech-language pathology/audiology) \$1.76
- Transportation & Ambulette \$1.14
- Oxygen (in all forms and delivery methods) \$.33
- Wheelchairs (including custom) and wheelchair repairs (\$.66)

In addition, we are responsible for a bed tax paid to the state on each bed (248) each day which has risen from \$6.25 to \$11.75.

Due to complex medical conditions of those we serve, St. Augustine Health Campus will feel the impact of these changes. For example, last year, Medicaid was billed approximately \$95,760 for transportation services and \$96,000 for wheelchairs for residents at St. Augustine. Under the new Medicaid reimbursement system, Medicaid reimbursement will be approximately \$66,400 and \$36,000 respectively leaving burden of \$89,300 to St. Augustine.

Over the past five years, Medicaid funding for care and services provided by St. Augustine has been reduced by 3%, while the cost of goods and services grew approximately 19%.

Not-for-profit facilities have the highest average quality ratings in the State as determined by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid. Studies show that quality in nursing homes is directly related to staffing levels of direct care workers which are 31% higher than in not-for-profit homes. Facilities such as St. Augustine who serve a higher percentage of Medicaid recipients and those with multiple and chronic illness – the most vulnerable - are impacted the most.

Advocacy Update

Being a voice for those who cannot speak is a core principle of the mission of St. Augustine Health Campus. Throughout the past months, this principle has been brought to life through our staff, residents, volunteers and families.

When Ohio Gov. Ted Strickland announced his proposed state budget, the outcome would have been detrimental to many skilled nursing facilities and the 50,000 Ohioans who rely on Medicaid. For St. Augustine this would have meant a \$2.6 million cut over the biennium.

For the St. Augustine family, standing by and watching this happen was not an option. Staff, residents, families and visitors used computers assembled in the lobby to send thousands of letters and e-mails to the Governor and members of the Ohio House and Senate. Residents and staff also made phone calls, wrote letters to editors of area newspapers and took numerous trips to Columbus to meet with State representatives.

During these advocacy efforts, family, staff and residents expressed the need to maintain quality care, something that cannot be done without the necessary funding. Families also expressed concern that they wouldn't be able to care for their loved one at home, even with a few hours of home care. As

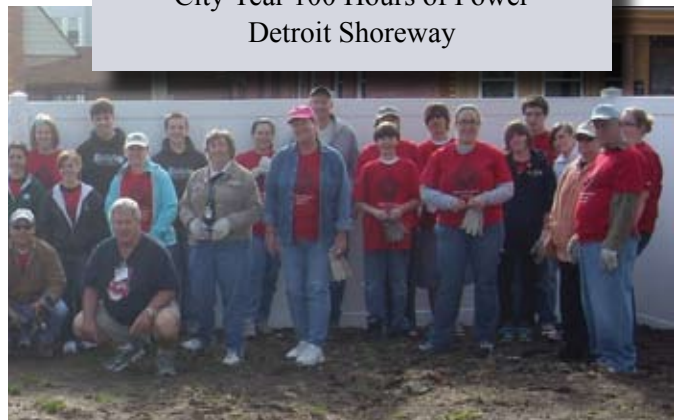
one resident said, "If it were your parent or spouse in the nursing home, what program or service would you say isn't really important to them and could be cut?"

The highlight of the advocacy efforts was the "Rally for Quality Care" that took place in front of the Manor. The Rally brought together Christians and Jews, East-siders and West-siders, underscoring that caring for those in need is a universal principle. Residents and staff from Menorah Park, Montiflore, Jennings Center for Older Adults, Eliza Jennings and Eliza Bryant joined volunteers, families and board members along Detroit with rally signs in hand while "God Bless the U.S.A." played over the loud speakers. Sign Language

Walking into an infant classroom in the St. Augustine Child Enrichment Center, you will see the one-year-olds using sign language. While infants and toddlers have a desire to communicate their needs and wishes, they lack the ability to do so because speech lags behind cognitive ability in the first months and years of life. This often leads to frustration and tantrums.

However, since hand-eye coordination develops sooner than verbal skills, infants can learn simple signs for common words such as "eat", "sleep", "more", "hug", "play", "cookie", "teddy bear", before they are able to speak. Sign language is taught in our classrooms and reinforced at home by the parents. The parents and teachers have seen a difference in the children since sign language was introduced.



Intergenerational music therapy is one of the programs provided on our campus through a grant by the Beck Center for the Arts.

You Went Where?!

When residents talked about wishing they could take a vacation, Life Enrichment Director Laura DeRose began working on making it happen. Beginning last Fall, Manor residents with a variety of disabilities, set out on three-day “Camping” trips—in handicapped-accessible cabins, of course! Groups of approximately 11 residents each have camped at Geneva-on-the-Lake State Park, Maumee Bay State Park and Lake Hope near Athens.

Residents planned the menus ahead of time, including snacks and drinks. Before the trip they researched the area and planned a variety of activities they wanted to do while they were there.

Unsure of what to expect, the staff were amazed at the difference in each resident. The fresh air, the freedom, just being away from “home” seemed to give residents new energy and more independence. Residents who would typically rely on staff to make their bed, dress them, etc., were doing these things on their own, without being asked.

Once at the cabins the residents unpacked (helping one another), helped put away groceries and began exploring the grounds around the cabins. Some played horseshoes in the grass, some sat on the deck talking and enjoying the sunshine.

The campers went fishing, on a wine tour, and swimming. The staff took them wherever they wanted to go! Residents did dishes after every meal. They not only made their own beds, but also helped others with theirs. They planned, prepared and helped cook the meals. When they began to get tired they went in, asked for assistance when needed and changed into their pajamas. They then joined others on the porch for one last talk of the day. Some enjoyed a rum and Coke before bed, some had beer with their meals. Some just enjoyed listening to others talk, some watched TV in the living room, while others played cards.



Upon returning each resident was interviewed about his or her experience, and they all said the same thing in their own words... “I FELT NORMAL AGAIN!” For some residents it brought back those great memories of camping with family. For others it was a completely new experience. But for all, it was something they thought they would never be able to do because of their age or disability.

Living life to the fullest—in spite of your age, illness or disability—is what Resident Centered Care is all about and how we live each day at St. Augustine Health Campus.

We are grateful to all who make contributions to our “Gift of Life Fund” especially the Dr. and Mrs. Theodore J. Castele Foundation. This fund subsidizes the cost of a variety of outings for residents who otherwise wouldn’t be able to go.

Leo:



Within six months, I went from full time employment as a building contractor to having a stroke, suffering kidney failure, and losing both legs due to complications of diabetes. For months after arriving at St. Augustine, I was depressed, angry and kept asking "Why me Lord". As I laid in my own self pity, all I could do was pray. In my prayers I heard God telling me that he had more for me to do, not to give up.

God puts people in your life to lift you up - emotionally, physically and spiritually. Between

my family and the staff of St. Augustine, that's exactly what happened. Through prayer and the staff, they helped me to a point of acceptance and the ability to move forward. I began to set my own personal goals. My faith and my St. Augustine family have helped me to learn to walk short distances with a walker and new prostheses.

After 16 months, I am now back at home but come to St. Augustine three times a week for outpatient therapy. Soon I will be walking in on my own!

Whom do we serve:

There is no such person as an average resident at St. Augustine Health Campus. We serve a variety of individuals who cross all economic, ethnic, religious, and social backgrounds. For example:

- An 18 year old who comes to us with a severe brain injury after a car accident.
- A stock broker diagnosed with HIV.
- The 42 year old mother of two who suffered a severe stroke and is paralyzed.
- A 50 year old man who's battle with sugar diabetes leads him to be a double amputee.
- The 70 year old couple looking for an assisted living where they can still enjoy their independence and not use up all of their savings.
- An 89 year old retired teacher in need of dialysis.
- A 90 year old grandmother nearing the end of life

Emulating Christ by serving those who lack the necessary resources to provide for themselves is what our Faith calls us to do. Working together makes the burden light as we continue to serve those in need. With the decrease in government reimbursements each year and the rising costs of goods and services, your charitable and in-kind donations are more important than ever.

- We provided care and services to over 674 in 2008.
- Over \$1.5 million provided in charitable care in 2008

Programs Provide Financial Assistance for Assisted Living

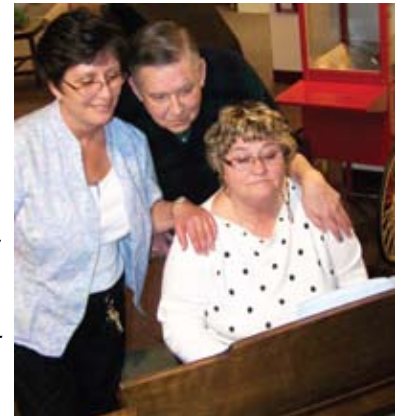
Assisted living at the Towers allows active individuals 55+ an opportunity to enjoy their retirement years with family and friends without the worries and hassles of home ownership. The Towers offers a variety of apartment sizes and styles filled with amenities that give resident and their families peace. At St. Augustine we have always believed that people of all incomes deserve to have access to affordable assisted living and that is why we strive to keep our rates reasonable ~ below market rate.



The Towers works with two programs that provide financial assistance for assisted living ~ the VA Benefit and the Assisted Living Waiver Program. Both are designed to help seniors afford assisted living and

help them remain in their apartments even if their resources run low.

The Veterans Aid and Attendance Benefit offered through the VA is largely unknown but helps to cover the cost of Assisted Living. A Veteran may be eligible for up to \$1,554 per month, while a surviving spouse is eligible for up to \$998 per month. A couple may be eligible for up to \$1,842 per month (*Increases each year for cost of living).



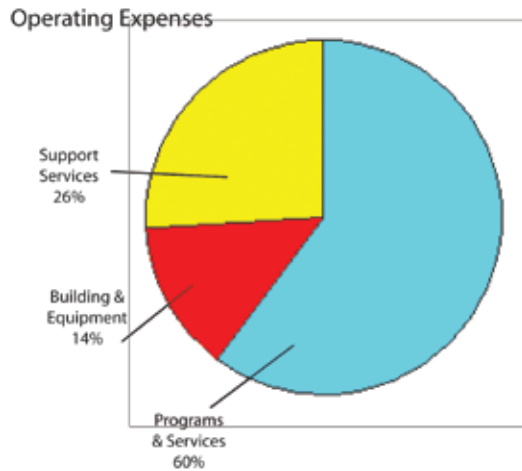
The Assisted Living Waiver Program is a statewide, government-funded program that allows eligible individuals to reside in and receive services from a licensed Assisted Living facility.

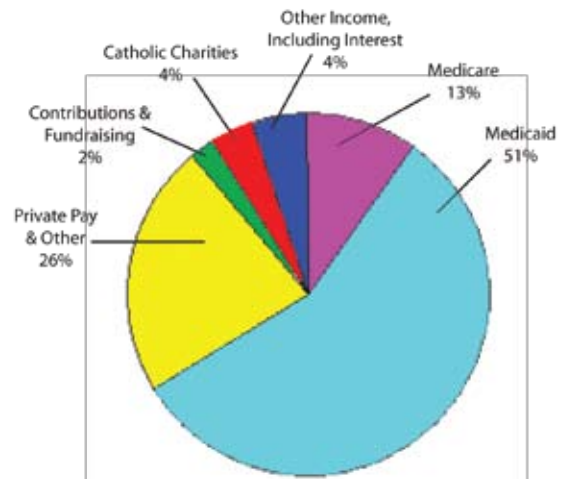

FINANCIAL REPORT



St. Augustine Manor provided over \$1.5 million in 2009 in charitable inpatient care to the medically frail and elderly who otherwise might not have received care. As the largest employer in the Detroit Shoreway neighborhood, St. Augustine Health Campus provides jobs to over 400 individuals and contributes approx. \$17.3 million to the economy in terms of payroll, payroll taxes and fringe benefits.

Revenue and Other Support



78% of residents served are on Medicaid. As Medicaid dollars continue to be cut (which represents over half of our annual revenue), we look to the generosity of donors, bequests, memorials, and corporate/foundation support to bridge the gap.

Serving Older Adults – A Profile

- Over the next 5 years, over 55,000 Ohioans will become over the age of 65.
- Between 2000 and 2025, the 65 and older population will increase more sharply than any other age group (more than 50%).
- Of this, 85 and older is the fastest growing population.
- The number of senior who are disabled will rise by 28%.
- The number of people paying into Medicare/Medicaid will be less than those who need it.
- Patient care needs (patient acuity) continues to grow steadily. Example: over the past 5 years, the number of daily meds taken increased more than 34%; intravenous meds grew 26%, those needing help from two or more persons with dressing and personal hygiene rose 18%.
- Home care provides approx. 4 hrs. of care per day leaving the other 20 hours a day without someone. Those who require 24 hour care in a nursing home deserve to have the best quality care and programs available. This takes money.

Did You Know?

Our logo is a symbol of our philosophy. The S and A refer to St. Augustine, looked upon as the founder of the Christian concept of theology, who believed man was helpless without God. The cross is the emblem of our Christian love, the arched M is symbolic of the acceptance of all who need our care and of the shelter and comfort we give.

Going green is all the rage these days, and St. Augustine Health Campus is doing its part to lower energy costs and help the environment. Through a Cleveland Carbon Fund grant awarded to St. Augustine by the Detroit Shoreway Community Development Organization, 400 compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs) were installed in apartments and common areas in St. Augustine Towers. It's expected that the installation of the energy saving bulbs will save the Towers up to 8% on its annual electricity bill. The Cleveland Carbon Fund is the first community-based carbon reduction fund in the U.S.

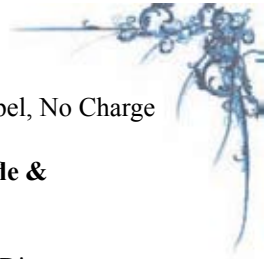
